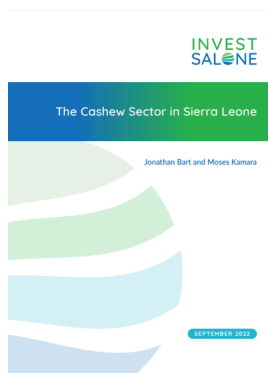


Leecon's local chicken feed could solve poultry challenges in Sierra Leone and boost maize production
